

2023 VS. 2024 NOTABLE COMPARISONS

Call Volume Increase – 385 calls (+5.40%)

Structure Fires Decrease - 16 calls (-26.67%)

Fire Alarm Activations Increase – 51 calls (+7.31%)

Traffic Accident Decrease – 67 calls (-9.45%)

Extrications Decrease – 9 calls (-40.91%)

Community Impact Increase – 786 people (+6.44%)

Mutual Aid Given Increase - 132 calls (+43.42%)

Mutual Aid Received Decrease – 214 calls (-17.57%)

All Units Turnout Time Decrease – (-1 second)
