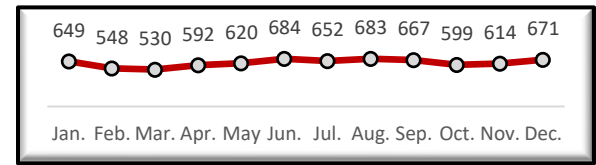

2023 VS. 2024 NOTABLE COMPARISONS

- Call Volume Increase – 385 calls (+5.40%)
- Structure Fires Decrease - 16 calls (-26.67%)
- Fire Alarm Activations Increase – 51 calls (+7.31%)
- Traffic Accident Decrease – 67 calls (-9.45%)
- Extrications Decrease – 9 calls (-40.91%)
- Community Impact Increase – 786 people (+6.44%)
- Mutual Aid Given Increase – 132 calls (+43.42%)
- Mutual Aid Received Decrease – 214 calls (-17.57%)
- All Units Turnout Time Decrease – (-1 second)
- All Units Travel Time Decrease – (-37 seconds)
